## Henry Timmers Exterior Facility and Grounds Update

- Bitumen Walkway: Ongoing issues with council's acceptance. We aim for a higher standard, with a surveyor scheduled for Thursday to assess and address pooling water issues.
- 2. **Volunteer Mondays:** Successful initiative with designated tasks for volunteers, such as window cleaning, BBQ area maintenance, and grounds upkeep.
