Board Report for External Facilities

Since previous meeting the following items have been attended to, or require attention:

- Fan Installation: A new fan is to be installed in the male toilet.
- Social Bowls Signage: The sign for social bowls has been installed on the outside fence.
- Scoreboard Signage: Scoreboard signs have been checked and updated.
- Scoreboard Stencils: I have been making holdfast and visitors stencils for the scoreboards but was later told they are not needed. Others have attended to the scoreboards.
- Electronic Scoreboards: These have been repaired and installed.
- Shade Installations: Shades have been installed.
- Windsocks: I made 2 new windsocks but was promptly informed they were not needed as we have flags. As I stillthought we had a need and I had this project in hand, I decided installed them. I received great feedback, so have now ordered additional ones for each green.
- Aluminum Seats: The seats on the southern side have been cleaned.
- Floodlights Adjustment: The floodlights over A and B greens willbeadjusted on Thursday from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Volunteers are needed to help assess the light spread over the greens-please ask members to attend.
- Bitumen Issues: The bitumen project has been problematic, and Lisa is currently working on rectifying the problem.
- Sponsor Signage: I will be installing an existing sponsor's sign with Barry Allen.


