#### **GOOD SAMARITAN LAW**

Recently a member raised the issue of liability when coming to the aid of another person, eg. using the defibrillator.

In Australia members are covered by the following legislation which covers anybody acting in good faith.

Good Samaritan laws offer legal protection to people who give reasonable assistance to those who are, or whom they believe to be injured, ill, in peril, or otherwise incapacitated. The protection is intended to reduce bystanders' hesitation to assist, for fear of being sued or prosecuted for unintentional injury or wrongful death.

#### The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

#### Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Good Samaritans (Limitation of Liability) Act 2002.

#### Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

#### **Good samaritans**

- 3. (1) A **good samaritan** is a person who, acting without any expectation of payment or any other form of consideration
- (a)comes to the aid of another (the victim) in an emergency; or
- (b)gives advice by telephone or some other form of telecommunication about the treatment of another (the **victim**) who is apparently in need of emergency treatment.
- (2) A good samaritan is not liable for personal injury to the victim arising out of a genuine attempt to help the victim unless gross negligence is established.
- (3) This section does not apply if the injury is covered by a policy of third party motor vehicle insurance.




