GREEN KEEPER REPORT

Greens

Weeds have been sprayed.

Synthetic carpet - left over – can be installed in the ditch on the croquet court.

A Green – addressing sodium level in bore water. Shandy mix is possible if needed. Need to re-grass the northern end, scarify and then cover for three weeks.

B Green - has in general held up well over winter months with good coverage at present. The north end now needs some heat however.

D Green – pleased that social bowlers are playing east west. Some of the synthetic carpet was cut a little too short, however, the ditches on D can be filled in with sand.

Irrigating back greens – currently investigating best way that greens can be on one controller, allowing watering at the same time.

Absence of Greenkeeper overseas – both Wayne Ruediger and Colin Hall to fill in.

The new system has been installed. There does not














appear to be any issues after installation. The new system is able to be programmed remotely.
